2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION

Main hazards: Risk of serious damage to eyes. Contact with wet cement, wet concrete or wet mortar may cause irritation, dermatitis or burns. Contact between cement powder and body fluids (eg sweat and eye fluid) may also cause skin and respiratory irritation, dermatitis or burns.

3. COMPOSITION / INFORMATION ON INGREDIENTS

Contains: Portland Cement

4. FIRST AID MEASURES (SYMPTOMS)

Skin contact: There may be irritation and redness at the site of contact.

Inhalation: Exposure may cause coughing or wheezing.

Inhalation: Remove casualty from exposure ensuring one's own safety whilst doing so. Consult a doctor.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES
